STORAGE AND USAGE OF PRIVATE INFORMATION (PRIVACY NOTICE)

We do not aim to store or use your Facebook profile unique ID, email or other personal details.

However, in case of an adverse event or product issue you report to us, we will need to store and use identifying information about you, such as your name, location, health related information or similar in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations (the "law") in order to communicate with you and to follow-up on safety information. By submitting your personal data on social media platforms you confirm, that we may use such data as described in this guideline. Additionally we ask you to contact us via our official report form on the Actelion website.

In general, access to your personal data will be restricted. In particular, it may be accessed by, disclosed or forwarded to those persons in Actelion's global organization who need safety information in order to evaluate and monitor the safety of Actelion products (in particular Actelion Global Drug Safety, Affiliate Safety Officer) or to whom we are compelled to provide it in connection with legal or regulatory requirements (in particular to regulatory authorities). In processing your personal data, we will fully comply with international recognized standards of data protection. In doing so, we ensure compliance of our staff with strict standards of security and confidentiality. However, if you report an adverse event or product issue on social media platforms, we cannot ensure the same level of data protection

as guaranteed on the official reporting procedure via our Actelion website.

We will not give access to any of your personal data to any third party. However, personal data may incidentally be transferred to a third party acting for or on behalf of Actelion, or in connection with Actelion's business, for further processing in accordance with the original purpose of the collection of the personal data. Wherever possible, we endeavor to ensure that both the obligation of non-disclosure and the intended use of the personal data are clearly indicated. Such third parties may adopt different privacy policies. However, we aim to ensure that such third parties provide the same degree of protection as we do, and, where appropriate, we will contractually bind a third party to process personal data only for the purpose explicitly authorized by us. Nevertheless, it is expressly understood that we will not share any personal data that is sensitive (e.g. medical history) with any third party without your prior and explicit consent, except to the extent that we are obliged to share your personal data as required by applicable law and only to the extent required by applicable law. Please note that if you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to comply with such request if we are obliged to keep your personal data as required by applicable law and only to the extent required by applicable law. However, we will, where practicable, inform third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred of your withdrawal of consent.

We will address your request in a prompt and accurate manner and free of charge. However, requests to delete personal data will be subject to any applicable legal and ethical reporting or document filing or retention obligations with which we must comply. In all other cases, we will keep personal data only as long as is reasonably required for the processing of the purpose for which the personal data were collected and in accordance with any applicable legal or ethical reporting or documentation retention requirements.

As part of the evaluation of your personal data may be transferred into and processed in countries with laws that do not provide for an adequate level of protection of personal data. For that purpose, contractual safeguards will be in place to secure such data and the access thereto. Despite all efforts, it cannot be excluded that foreign government agencies or related organizations force access to personal data without observing due process rules. We will undertake best efforts to enjoin such unauthorized access and duly support you to assert your privacy rights in such jurisdiction.
